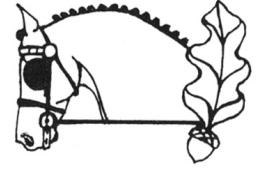

# 2010 Pacific Region Driven Dressage Festival



Once again, Brass Oak Driving Society will sponsor the Pacific Region Driven Dressage Festival in Arroyo Grande, California, on July 31 and August 1. Now in its 19th year, the Festival is always an exciting event, offering a variety of dressage tests — from Training

to Advanced. This is a unique opportunity for drivers to enter the level their equine is currently working at and also a level higher to school for more advanced work. The Test of Choice gives drivers a chance to drive the tests a 2nd time, or another ADS/FEI test not listed.

**ENTRIES OPEN:** June 1, 2010 — **CLOSING DATE:** July 6, 2010

**METHOD OF ACCEPTING ENTRIES:** First come first serve

**LOCATION:** 235 Cimarron Way, Arroyo Grande, CA 93420

**LEVELS/DIVISIONS:** Training, Preliminary, Intermediate, Advanced

**CLASSES:** Open/each division. Singles, Pairs, Multiples, Musical Freestyle, Pas de Deux. Classes may be combined.

#### **DRESSAGE TESTS:**

*TRAINING:* Tests 2, 4 & Test of Choice

*PRELIMINARY:* Tests 1, 2, 5 & Test of Choice

*INTERMEDIATE:* Tests 2, 3 & Test of Choice

*ADVANCED:* Tests 1, 8A, 8B, 9, 10 & Test of Choice

*MUSICAL FREESTYLE / PAS DE DEUX*

**AWARDS:** Class awards, 1-6 place. Best Score award for each level and Best Score of Show award.

**FEEES:** \$25 entry per test; post entry \$35 per test, space allowing. No entry fee refund after closing date.

\$65 stabling fee per pipe corral, includes grounds fee; available July 25-Aug 2, no 1st bedding.

\$25 stall deposit, separate check.

\$5 CA Drug Fee per horse

\$25 camping fee; \$15 grounds fee (day use).

\$10 per person (prepurchase) daily continental breakfast and lunch

\$25 per person, Saturday dinner

**FACILITIES:** Grass arena and warmup area; ranch roads. Pipe corrals grouped near parking and camping areas. Limited electricity for RVs. Reservation required and bring extensions cords. Shower available. Food available on grounds. Pismo Dunes State Park nearby — about 8 miles to equestrian parking lot.

**MISC:** Out-of-state horses, negative Coggins required to comply with entry into California. All participants and guests on grounds must sign a release of liability waiver, available from Secretary. Minors under age 18 participating as a driver, groom, or passenger must wear an ASTM/SEI certified safety helmet. Children **MUST** be under parental supervision at all times. Please keep dogs on a leash.

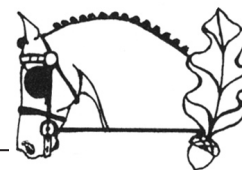
