- ENTRIES OPEN:** June 1, 2009    **ENTRIES CLOSED:** July 6, 2009    **METHOD OF ACCEPTING ENTRIES:** First come first serve
- LOCATION:** 235 Cimarron Way, Arroyo Grande, CA 93420
- LEVELS/DIVISIONS:** Training, Preliminary, Intermediate, Advanced
- CLASSES:** Open, each division. Singles, Pairs, Multiples, Musical Freestyle, Pas de Deux
- DRESSAGE TESTS:** Training—Tests #2, #4, & Test of Choice; Preliminary—Tests #2, #5 (multiples), #6, & Test of Choice  
Intermediate—Tests #1, #6, & Test of Choice; Advanced—FEI Tests #8A/8B, #9, #10, ADT Advanced Level Test #2, & Test of Choice; Musical Freestyle; Pas de Deux  
*Note: Drivers are encouraged to enter the level their equine is currently working at and also one level higher to school for more advanced work. Test of Choice is an opportunity to drive one of the tests a second time or another ADS/FEI test not listed above. Please indicate on entry form. Classes may be combined.*

\$5 per horse CA Drug Fee; \$25 camping fee; \$15 grounds fee (day use).

- SCHEDULE:** Stable opens Wed, 9AM; contact Secretary for early arrival; Secretary's office opens Friday, 3pm
- FACILITIES:** Ring/warm-up area footing—grass; pipe corrals grouped near parking and camping areas;  
Limited electricity for RVs with your extension cords, reservation required; restroom with shower;  
food available on grounds. Pismo Dunes State Park nearby, about 8 mi to equestrian parking lot.

- DIRECTIONS:** From Hwy 101 to Los Berros Rd turnoff; north of Nipomo and south of Arroyo Grande; Go east 300 yds. Turn left on Cimarron Way across from Windmill Farm. Follow 235 signs 1 mile to event.
- MISC:** Out-of-state horse—negative Coggins to comply with entry into California.  
**PLEASE DRIVE SLOWLY on dirt roads to minimize dust.**  
Children **MUST** be under parental supervision at all times.  
All participants and anyone on the grounds must sign a release of Liability waiver. Minors under the age 18 participating as a driver, groom, or passenger must wear an ASTM/SEI certified safety helmet.

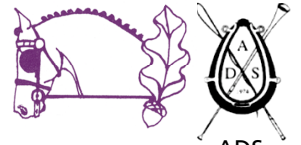
